INSTRUCTIONS

(Inter-College Migration)

- 1. Migration Fee: Rs.220/- (including Rs.30/-as cost of the application form)
- 2. No Student who has joined one College shall be admitted to another during the same course unless:
 - a. The Principals of the colleges concerned agree and the migration Certificate is issued by the University;
 - b. The Principal of the college from which he/she intends to migrate has given the leaving certificate;
 - c. He/she is registered with Panjab University.
- 3. If the candidate is provisionally promoted, or a detained student or one who has been degraded or against whom any disciplinary action has been taken, etc. etc., the principal shall specially mention this in his remarks.
- 4. When the University has sanctioned migration of a student from one college to another college, he/she must join the new college within 15 days. If a student does not avail himself/herself of the migration, within fifteen days, he/she shall apply a fresh to revalidate his/her previous migration, on payment of fresh fee of Rs.220/-(including Rs.30/- as the cost of the application form)
- 5. Migration of a student from a professional college to an Arts or Science College and vice-versa is not permissible.
- 6. Candidates who pass B.A./B.Sc. Part I/II/, M.A. I, B.Com. Part I/II, Pre-Engineering, Pre-Medical and Pre-University examinations are not required to seek migration from one college to another if they do not wish to continue studies in the previous college from which they passed B.A.I/II or M.A.I, B.Com. Part I/II, Pre-Engineering, Pre-Medical and Pre-University Examinations, but they will be required to produce a college leaving certificate from the college which they last attended, for admission to the new college.
- In all correspondence with the University till the receipt of Migration certificate, Name, Father's Name, Registration No., and the University fee Receipt Number and date must be quoted.
- 8. Attach attested photocopy of the certificate of the last examination passed/failed.
